

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

Read all instructions before using this massage chair.

DANGER-To reduce the risk of electric shock:

- 1) Always unplug this appliance from the electrical outlet immediately after using and before cleaning.
- 2) Never use pins or other metallic fasteners with this appliance.
- 3) Carefully examine the covering before each use. Discard the appliance if the covering shows any sign of deterioration, such as checking, blistering, or cracking.
- 4) Keep Dry Do not operate in a wet or moist condition.

WARNING-To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock, or injury to persons:

- 1) An appliance should never be left unattended when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use, and before putting on or taking off parts.
- 2) Do not operate under blanket or pillow. Excessive heating can occur and cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- 3) Close supervision is necessary when this appliance is used by, on, or near children, invalids, or disabled persons. Keep children away from extended foot support.
- 4 Use this appliance only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not recommended by the manufacturer.

- 18) The apparatus shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and that no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the apparatus.
- 19) An apparatus with CLASS I construction shall be connected to a MAINS socket outlet with a protective earthing connection
- 20) The appliance coupler is used as the disconnect device, the disconnect device shall remain readily Operable.
- 21) This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- 22) If it is not in use for a long time or after use, please turn off the power and pull out the power plug.
- 23) Do not damage, break, over-bend, compress, tighten, wind, rotate or knot the power cord.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

This massage chair is intended for household use only.

Usage Environment

- Do not use the massage chair in an excessively humid or dusty environment as this may result in malfunction or electric shock.
- \bullet Do not use the massage chair in a room with a temperature of 104 $^\circ~\,$ F or higher.
- Do not expose the massage chair to heaters, stoves or direct sunlight.
- Place and use the massage chair on an even, non-slip floor.
- The massage chair is designed for home use and not for commercial purposes.

▲ Caution

- The massage chair is to be used indoors only.
- If you use the massage chair in a cold room, do not increase the room temperature abruptly. It is recommended that you increase the temperature gradually to a normal level.
- If the massage chair is stored in a cold place and is being brought into a warm environment, it is advisable to wait one hour before use. This is because its performance may not be at optimum level, as there may be water droplets on the mechanical parts due to condensation.Using the massage chair under such conditions may result in malfunction.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS • Safety Precautions

- To ensure safe and correct use of the massage chair, do not operate it without reading this operation manual carefully.
- Do not use the massage chair when the upholstery or seat is removed. This may cause injury or malfunction.
- Do not use the massage chair in combination with other therapeutic equipment or electric blanket, etc., as this may result in ineffectiveness or injury.
- Do not use the massage chair an hour before or after eating as this may have adverse effects on the user.
- Do not allow children or pets to play around the massage chair, e.g., behind the backrest, under the seat or leg rest of the massage chair. This may result in injury.

- Do not rest or place heavy objects on the armrests, leg rest or backrest as this may result in malfunction or injury.
- Do not use the massage chair when your body is wet.
- Do not operate the massage chair with wet hands.
- It is not recommended to use the massage for more than 15 minutes.
- Do not perform continuous massage on the same spot of your body for more than 5 minutes at a time as this may result in excessive stimulation and may have adverse effects.
- Do not insert your hand or foot along the paths of the massage rollers during use as this may cause injury.
- · Stop operation immediately if you experience any discomfort.
- This product is not intended for self-treatment of conditions that should be managed by a qualified health care provider.
- People on medication or with medical conditions, please consult your doctor before use.
- · Please do not use the product if you are not feeling well.
- Remove all scarves, neckties, necklaces and jewelry before using the massager.

• People with Medical Conditions

Consult your doctor before use if you:

- are under medical rest as ordered by a doctor.
- have spinal disorders, an abnormal spinal condition or have suffered a spinal injury.
- · have back problems.
- · have diabetes, osteoporosis or sensory impairment.
- · have joint dysfunction.
- · have a pacemaker or other electronic medical devices.
- may be pregnant.
- · have phlebitis or thrombosis.
- · have an increased risk for blood clots.
- · had recent surgery.
- have surgical pins, screws, or anything mechanical implanted in your body.

• Instances When the massage chair Should Not Be Used

In the following events, please switch off the main power switch immediately and disconnect the power cord from the electrical outlet:

- If water is accidentally spilled onto the massage chair. This may result in electric shock or malfunction.
- If the fabric of the backrest is torn and the internal components are exposed.
- If pain or discomfort is felt during massage, stop operation immediately and consult your doctor.
- If you detect any malfunction or any other abnormal condition during operation.
- If there is a power failure. Injury may occur when power is restored unexpectedly.
- If there is lightning.

• Assembly and Repair of the massage chair

- Do not disassemble the backrest cover of the massage chair. Touching the internal components may result in malfunction or electric shock.
- The massage chair must only be professionally serviced or repaired. Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the massage chair yourself.

• Things to Note About the Power Plug and Cord


- Check that the Alternating Current (AC) voltage corresponds with the specifications indicated for the massage chair.
- Do not connect or disconnect the power plug from the electrical outlet with wet hands. This may result in malfunction or electric shock.
- When disconnecting the power plug, pull it by holding the plug, not the cord.
- Although operation will be stopped automatically by the Auto-Timer function, always remember to switch off the main power switch after use.
- Do not place the power cord under the massage chair or any other heavy objects.
- Do not wind the power cord around the massage chair as this may damage the cord and result in a fire or electric shock.
- Do not operate the massage chair with a damaged cord or extension cord.
- · Do not use the massage chair if the electrical outlet is loose.
- If the power cord is damaged, it should be replaced by a qualified technician.

• Grounding Instructions

This product must be grounded. If it should malfunction or breakdown, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

DANGER - Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in a risk of electric shock. Check with a qualified electrician or serviceman if you are in doubt as to whether the product is properly grounded. Do not modify the plug provided with the product - if it will not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician.


This product is for use on a nominal 100-240V~ circuit and has a grounding plug that looks like the plug illustrated in sketch A as following illustration. Make sure that the product is connected to an outlet having the same configuration as the plug. No adapter should be used with this product.



Preparation Before Use


Move the Chair

- Please turn off the main power and unplug the power from the electrical outlet.
- Tilt the chair backward as shown in the picture below and wheel it to the desired location.
- Please cover the floor with mat when move the massage chair in case of any damage of floor will be made.




Place the Chair

Please make sure that there is an allowance of more than 5cm(2") behind the massage chair, and more than 35cm(13.8") in front of the massage chair to allow the backrest to recline without obstruction during operation.




Install Legrest


• Attach the push rod of the legrest to the frame, then insert the pin to make it locked.




• Insert the air pipes ① of the legrest into the counterpart ② of the chair.





• Put the legrest bracket (3) into the fixed axis (4).




• Insert the clip (5), installation is complete.








Step1: Connect the controller cord with chair wire



Step 2: Installing other parts


 Connect the controller to the electrical inlet with electrical cord (pay attention to the point position of plug and socket).



Power	J	Connect the power supply, press this button to start the massage chair. It will start the body detection and then start the default automatic program for massage.
Menu		Press this button to enter the UI interface.
Stop	F 1	Press this button to pause the massage function. Press again to resume the original massage function.
Auto	0	Press this button to switch between multiple automatic program functions. The specific display is subject to the actual product.
4-Way Direction & OK Button	• ok •	Under the menu UI interface, press the arrow keys to select the corresponding function, press the OK button to confirm the function.
Airbag	*	Press this button to the airbag menu. Use the 4-way button to adjust and select your desired massage area and intensity.
Heat	X	Press this button to turn ON/OFF the heating function.
Zero-G	zero	Press the button to recline chair to Zero-G angle. The screen shows the Zero-G icon. If the icon doesn't appear on the screen, the Zero-G function is turned off.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Maintenance methods

Please follow the below steps to clean leather and plastic parts

1.Please ensure the main switch is off and the power plug is unplugged from the electrical outlet.

2.Dip a soft, dry cloth in water or warm water containing 3% to 5% neutral detergent and wring it thoroughly.


3.Clean the leather and plastic parts.

4. Then wipe with dry soft cloth.

5.Let it dry naturally.

Warning

- Do not use alcohol, thinner, gasoline and other chemicals for cleaning.
- Do not dry the surface with a blower.
- Do not iron the fabric.
- During maintenance, always unplug the power plug. Do not unplug it by wet hands.
- Please use a dust cover to avoid dust if you won't use the chair for a long time.
- As fabric's color may be dyed on the leather, be careful when using denim and colored cloth to wipe the product.
- Wipe the product with the melamine foam dipped in mild detergent, if the dirt is hard to remove.
- Do not let the leather touch plastic in case of the color fading.
- \bullet Water temperature should not exceed 104 ${\rm F}$

Troubleshooting

If there is still an abnormality after the following checks, to prevent any accident, please stop using the massage chair immediately. Please unplug the power cord from the outlet and contact with the dealer or the nearby customer service center.

Costway products include the following warranty:

This Costway massage chair has a three-year warranty for both parts and labor.

Costway customer service will not issue Return Material Authorizations (RMAs) for products due to buyer's remorse. RMAs will be issued only when product has quality problem. Costway products will be either repaired by the customer or by an in-home technician.

Service And Technical Support:

Customers can contact Costway's customer service department at 213-401-2666 at any time Monday through Friday or via email at topsupport@costway.com for warranty or service issues.

Customers are required to provide dated proof of purchase (sales receipt) when they contact Costway service department regarding a repair.



A Costway customer service representative will attend to most customer inquiries, however, in some cases, when necessary, a technical service specialist will provide advanced support.

Non-warranty repair is provided on a "per incident" basis. Costway customer service will verify that the unit has failed and provide instructions for repairing a unit. All applicable repairs, parts, shipping, handling, local tax, and a "per incident" fee will be charged for non-warranty repairs.

Product Repairs

Many Costway product repairs may be performed by the customer in their own home with parts and instructions supplied by Costway, such as remote controller replacements that don't require a technician. Floor Models and Demonstration Units have a prorated warranty period that begins the day the model is placed on the floor and connected to an electrical outlet by the retail partner. Proof of purchase (sales receipt) is required in order to obtain warranty service and parts. Non-warranty parts and service are available at a "per incident" rate.

Warranty Coverage Period: Warranty coverage begins on the date of customer purchase. Proof of purchase (sales receipt) is required for all



warranty repairs. The warranty period is measured by continuous calendar days based on a seven-day week.

Warranties do not cover any loss or damage resulting from improper installation, unauthorized repairs or modifications, improper use of electrical/power supply, loss of power, dropped products, a malfunction of or damage to an operating part from failure to provide manufacturer's recommended maintenance, transportation damage, theft, abuse, misuse, neglect, vandalism, or environmental conditions (fire, floods, rust, corrosion, sand, dirt, windstorms, hail, earthquakes, or exposure to other weather conditions), loss of use during the period the product is at a repair facility, or otherwise awaiting parts or repair.

Damage due to shipping and handling does not constitute a defect under this warranty.

Under no circumstance shall Costway or its representatives be liable for indirect, consequential, or incidental damages (including damages for lost profits, business interruption, bodily injury, medical harm, and the like), even if any party has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

Warranties are non-transferable and shall be in lieu of any other warranty, express or implied, including but not limited to any implied



warranty or merchant ability or fitness for particular use.

Costway's sole liability and the purchaser's exclusive right shall be for the repair, or at Costway's option, for the replacement of defective part.

In the event you detect and report a defect in the workmanship or material of the Equipment, during the Service Period, then the Administrator shall provide the services hereinafter described.

Your purchase of the Extended Warranty shall constitute your acceptance to the terms of this Limited Warranty including the indemnification provisions.

1) DEFINITIONS - For the purpose of this Limited Warranty, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

(1) "Equipment" shall mean a Costway product or system;

- (2) "Customer" shall mean only the residential end-user of theEquipment who is the original purchaser of the equipment from theDistributor, from an authorized reseller.
- (3) Usages of "you" or "your" refer to the Customer;
- (4) "Commencement Date" shall mean the date on which the Equipment is first purchased by a Customer from the Distributor or from an authorized reseller;
- (5) "Service Period" shall mean the period commencing on the Commencement Date;



(6) "Administrator" shall mean Costway. Usage of "we," "us," or "our" shall mean the Administrator. You may contact the Administrator if you have questions regarding this coverage. We can be reached by phone at 213-401-2666.

2) COVERAGE - During the Service Period, we will repair or replace, at our sole discretion, any defective Equipment. We will return the Equipment to a properly functioning state. To obtain such service, you must be able to provide us with the original, dated proof of purchase (sales receipt) for the Equipment. This Limited Warranty extends only to Customers. Only our representatives may perform repairs on the Equipment under this Limited Warranty. Replaced parts shall be covered under this Limited Warranty for the remainder of the Service Period or for thirty (30) days, whichever is longer. We will provide on-site service as necessary on regular workdays. Submission of the Extended Warranty Card form is not a condition precedent to obtaining service under this Limited Warranty. If a particular replacement part is not available from the manufacturer, we will make reasonable efforts to locate a compatible replacement part. If we are unable to locate a compatible part, we may replace your Equipment with a similar product. Under no circumstances



shall the retail replacement value exceed the original net price paid for the Equipment. In the event you choose not to accept a replacement for your Equipment, we shall no longer be responsible for making repairs under this Limited Warranty.

3) EXCLUSIONS - This Limited Warranty does not include service needed on Equipment as a result of any of the following:

(1) Installation, set-up, moving, or relocation from the originally installed location;

(2) Cosmetic changes, tears, or failure of fabrics, woods, foam, pads, plastics, upholsteries, exterior coverings, and damages and changes resulting from normal wear and tear;

(3) Negligence, misuse, abuse, improper maintenance, electrical
 disturbances and power surges, acts of nature, or work, attachments,
 additions, alterations, or modifications by persons other than authorized
 Administrator service providers;

(4) Failure by the Customer to use a high-quality surge protector during the entire Service Period; (5) Improper operating environments;



(6) Any problem not involving a defect;

(7) Damage or malfunction whatsoever caused by an animal or pet;

- (8) Damage or malfunction whatsoever caused by liquids of any kind;
- (9) Rental, business, commercial, institutional, or other non-residential use;

(10) Unnecessary service requirement. If no problem is found upon diagnosis by us or any other third party, you may be charged our standard rate for shipping costs and parts;

- (11) Dropped products or components (including remote controls);
- (12) Use of any item with the Equipment that is not designated for use with the Equipment; and
- (13) Field service requires pre-approval and must be performed by Costway's authorized field service personnel. Field service is only available in certain areas. Please visit www.costway.com and www.costway.ca for the latest information regarding field service.

4) YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES - You shall:

(1) Operate the Equipment in an environment meeting the



requirements delineated in the Equipment's owner manual and other provided instructions;

(2) Protect the supply of electricity to the Equipment through the use a high-quality surge protection device;

(3) Permit no work on the Equipment except by our authorized service providers;

(4) Have an adult representative present whenever we provide support services;

(5) Perform telephone or email diagnostic procedures as requested by us;

(6) Safeguard and return (at our expense) all replacement parts shipped to you. Either the part to be replaced or the replacement part or item shipped to you must be returned to the Distributor upon request.

5) EXCULPATION AND INDEMNIFICATION - Our maximum liability under this Limited Warranty is limited to the cost of repairing or replacing defective Equipment. We shall not be liable to you for incidental and



consequential damages. Under no circumstances shall you or anyone else ever be deemed to be a third-party beneficiary of the agreement.
