Open key: press this button to switch on and off

Auto Key: Press this key to cycle through Auto Mode 1 / Mode 2 / Mode 3.

Emergency stop button: Press this button to stop all functions. At this time, you can use the massage chair only after pressing the key to turn off the power and use it for emergency situations.

Heating button: press this button to turn on and off the heating function Manual: Press this button to turn on the kneading massage (red light), turn on the sniper massage (green light), turn on the kneading sniper (yellow light) and switch between three states.

Zero Gravity: In the power-on state, press this button to start the chair and lie down in zero gravity state, the indicator light is red, and then press the chair to return to the original state.

Pneumatic button: press this button to select the pressure of the ring (weak/ strong/ off) Speed button: When the manual massage method is selected, press this button to switch the speed between medium speed, high speed, and low speed.

Move up/down: When selecting manual massage, press and hold the up and down keys to perform a fixed position massage. To exit the positioning massage, just press the area button to enter the area massage

Part key: Press the stop button, the massage machine will cycle through the whole body, the upper body and the lower body area to select the corresponding function. Collapse / lie down: under the boot. Long sit posture adjustment up/down button. The whole machine is adjusted up/down, and the machine will stop at the current position when released.


Press the massage program button on the right armrest control panel to select the automatic massage program that suits you.





Costway customer service will not issue Return Material Authorizations (RMAs) for products due to buyer's remorse. RMAs will be issued only when product has quality problem. Costway products will be either repaired by the customer or by an in-home technician.

Service And Technical Support:
